

Food/Farm Safety Training

The following is a list of rules for <u>all</u> volunteers to review prior to a gleaning activity. These items are required to meet produce safety requirements. You will need to review these rules each gleaning year.

- 1. Absolutely no pets are allowed in any fields.
- All volunteers must stay in the specific fields assigned by the farmer and glean manager.
- 3. Leave no trace. All trash is to be collected. This includes organic items like apple cores, orange rinds, banana peels, etc.
- 4. Verify any containers or transportation beds have been cleaned prior to produce contact, including buckets and truck beds.
- 5. If using tools, verify they have been cleaned prior to use. If cleaning on site, remember water is to be collected.
- Bathroom use in fields is prohibited one must use a bathroom facility. Hands
 must be washed with soap and water for 30 seconds prior to returning to the
 field. All wastewater from washing of hands after restroom use must be
 collected.
- 7. If entering another facility on the farm site, verify with farmer the proper path to take or if shoes need to be removed or covered.
